



NatureBlitz Rules & Code of Conduct

Respect the people around you, and respect nature at all times.

- 1. Have fun! Take pictures and share online #NatureBlitz @NatureCanada.
- 2. Do not litter: Pack out what you pack in.
- 3. Avoid Poison Ivy and Wild Parsnip (pictures provided).
- 4. Do not damage or pick any plants or other vegetation, and leave all nuts, berries and other natural materials for wildlife.
- 5. Listen to your guide at all times.
- 6. Do not remove any natural materials from this area.
- 7. Report any problems or concerns to your guide, or at the base camp tent.
- 8. **Do not disturb or harm the sensitive species in this area.** Some of those species are **protected** by federal and/or provincial laws.
- 9. **Stay on designated trails and pathways at all times**. Walkers, cyclists and other path users have the right-of-way.
- 10. Stay within the NatureBlitz area, as shown on the map.

IMPORTANT! DO NOT TOUCH THESE PLANTS!

Poison Ivy | Herbe à puce

Do not touch this plant! Grows along the edges of footpaths and the bike pathway where there is tree cover overhead. It most commonly grows as a trailing vine.





Wild Parsnip | Panais sauvage

Do not touch this plant! Grows along the edges of footpaths and the bike pathway, usually in open areas. Can grow as high as 1.5 metres tall.
