BFKS 2020 Toolkit Content

Step 1: Get Management Endorsement

Your employees will be more likely to want to participate if management is leading the charge. Have management be the first to form a team, to send out an email encouraging the event, and most of all support to you in your efforts to recruit and incentivize participation and fundraising. Why should management be interested in this event? Not only does it give back to the local community demonstrating corporate social responsibility, but this is a great team building event that all employees can participate to. Each team has up to 6 bowlers and you can have as many teams as you want. The company can cover the minimum \$180 fundraising contribution or encourage the employees to raise the funds themselves. It is probably one of the easiest and most cost efficient team building events every year!
