Bring a kayak, canoe, paddleboard, sailboat, powerboat or whatever floats. We need you on the water!

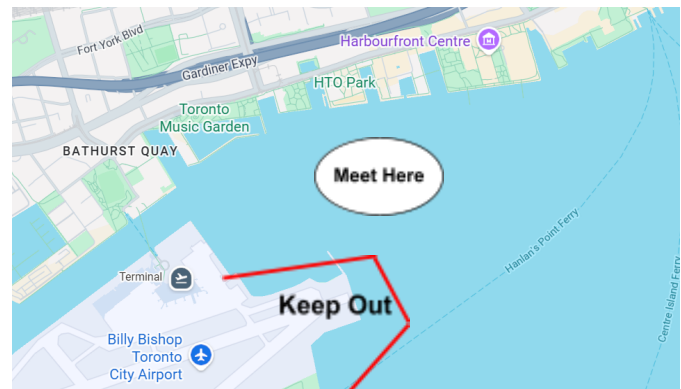
By participating on the water you are doing so at your own risk. Please take all necessary precautions including checking the weather and water conditions before setting out, ensuring you have a personal floatation device with you at all times, and giving way to other boats and kayaks.

Be at the meeting point on the water Sunday, July 26, 11:30 AM

The rally and march on land will be from 10:30 AM - 12:30 PM, ending in **HTO Park** where we'll be able to meet you at the water's edge.

Be at the meeting point by 11:30 AM

Details for Boaters:

If you are a paddler: The closest launch is Cherry Beach (foot of Cherry Street about 3 km away). **Arrive by 10:30am** to make it to the protest site on time (see image).

If you are a power boater: Please monitor your VHF radio channel 69. Give way to smaller boats, sail boats, kayaks and canoes. The water will be very busy. No wake! Power and sailboats should remain south of the small kayaks and canoes

If you are a sailor: Arrive at or before 11:30 am in the area immediately to the east of the Marine Exclusion Zone. Your choice of sail or power depends on weather and number of boats.
