Family Charades

What you'll need:

- Charade prompts
- Friends and family
- Hat, bowl, or any other container
- Hourglass, egg timer, watch, or other time keeper
- Somewhere to gather (in person or virtually)

Steps

- 1. Print these instructions with the charade prompts below.
- 2. Cut out the different prompts, fold them, and place them in the hat.
- 3. Want to add your own prompts? Just write them down and cut them out!

Rules of play:

- One by one, each player takes a turn.
- During the turn, the player picks one prompt from the hat.
- The player must then act out the prompt while all other players try to guess! Use your timer to ensure each player gets the same amount of time.

Helpful hints

- Set up a video call with friends and family to play charades from a distance.
- Don't be afraid to make up your own prompts and add them to the hat!
