


Writing a letter to your MP: A Time for Hope

Thank you for all you do to support our local community. Your work makes a real difference to the lives of many.

Here at , we have joined the St Vincent de Paul Society (SVP) in learning about the challenges asylum seekers face when they are given refugee status in this country.

We learnt that the government has recently changed its policy on the number of days refugees have to find permanent accommodation before the government support is stopped. This used to be 7 days, which later increased to 28 days, and now it is 56 days. This change gives many people hope, but we believe hope doesn't need to be temporary.

We are informed that the policy is a temporary measure until June 2025 and are writing to ask that this policy is made permanent.

We would like to see this made permanent to give all refugees the hope of a brighter future, one that is safe and secure in knowing that they will not end up homeless.

We would really appreciate your help in raising this issue in parliament, because we believe that everybody deserves a home.

We have included some examples of the ways we are bringing hope to others, and we would like to see you take action and do the same on this topic.
