



The Transfiguration

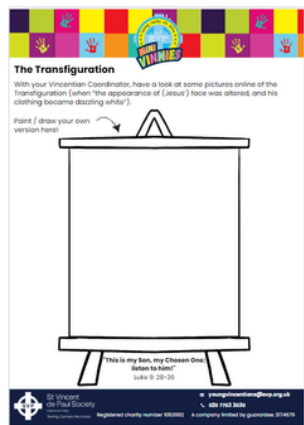
Leader's guide

Things you'll need:

- A Bible/access to the passage Luke 9: 28-36
- Website <https://artuk.org/discover/stories/what-was-the-transfiguration-of-jesus-and-how-has-it-been-portrayed-in-art>
- The Transfiguration worksheet

This activity helps Mini Vinnies to understand the significance of the Transfiguration, to look at artists' interpretations and get creative with their own works of art. This worksheet can be used on its own or as part of the Mini Vinnies' Spiritual Reflection Guides (Year C).

1. Read out the story of the Transfiguration from Luke 9: 28-36.
2. With your Mini Vinnies, have a look at different interpretations of the Transfiguration online. You can use this website:

3. Ask the Mini Vinnies: "What similarities/differences do you see? Which one is your favourite and why?"



4. Using the worksheet, ask your group to each draw or paint their own interpretation of the story.
5. They can share what they drew and compare ideas. Perhaps you can make a display in your classroom?



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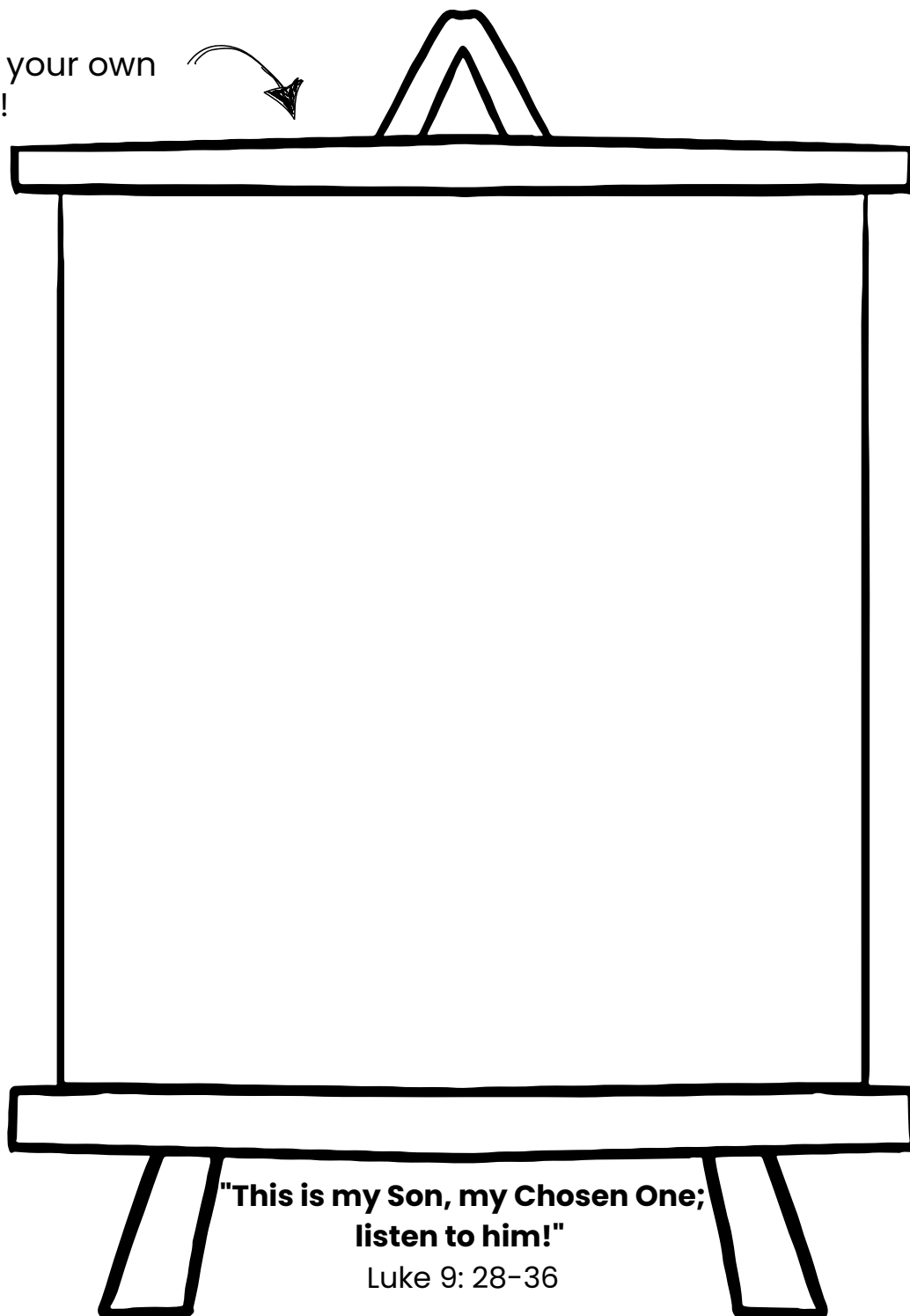
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The Transfiguration
