Visit concentration camps, death camps, ghettos, synagogues, Cemeteries and celebrate a beautiful Shabbat in Krakow.

- Warsaw Ghetto
- Tarnow: A vibrant Jewish community that once existed.
- Zbylitowska Gora: Site of mass murder during the Holocaust.
- Kazimierz (Krakow): Explore the historic Jewish quarter.
- Krakow Ghetto: Visit the WWII ghetto and remnants of the ghetto wall.
- Yeshivat Chachmei Lublin
- Majdanek Concentration Camp
- Lezajsk (Lizensk): Pilgrimage to the grave of R' Elimelech of Lezajsk.
- Lancut Synagogue: Admire the beautifully restored synagogue and learn about Chassidut in Poland.
- Auschwitz-Birkenau: Tour the largest Nazi concentration and extermination camp.
