## The children and youth we support



An estimated **59,283 children and youth** in Canada are in foster or group homes.

Almost 300,000 children are identified as at risk of abuse and neglect in Canada.



The average youth in care moves between 5 foster homes, disrupting their lives with each move.



**Exposure to trauma is almost universal**amongst children and
youth in the child welfare
system.



**46% of kids in care** in Ontario **graduate from high school,** compared with 83% of their peers.





Each year, 2,300 young people must "age out" of care as early as 18 years of age and transition to independent living.

## 82% have been diagnosed with special needs. These

can include physical, cognitive, emotional, behavioural, and social difficulties.

Youth leaving care are at a

greater risk of experiencing incarceration, homelessness, unemployment, and reliance on public assistance.



Youth involved in the child welfare system are 193 times more likely to become homeless than the general population.

## It takes a community

Together, we are creating a community of support for children an youth involved in Canada's child welfare system. By joining the Stand Up for Kids movement, you can help us create transformational change for our country's most vulnerable kids across the following priority areas:

**Strengthening families:** We know that, most often, children do better when their families raise them, not the child welfare system. In 2022-23 our programs and partnerships supported 2,800 children and families at risk connecting them to the life-changing resources and programs that allowed them essential resources that reduced the number of children in care.



**Supporting kids in care:** Unlike children growing up in permanent families, those growing up in care lack many of the basics most kids take for granted, like a safe and stable home, and caring adults to help support their growth. In 2022-23, the Foundation supported 8,366 children and youth in care, connecting them to resources that provide them a sense of stability and belonging, fuel their interests and passions, and keep them in school.



**Empowering youth in transition:** When most kids turn 18, they've got the support of a caring parent, access to car keys, and a place to come home to. But when kids in care turn 18, they no longer receive support from the child welfare system and are completely on their own, at risk of homelessness and poverty. In 2022-23, the Foundation helped 3,936 former youth in care access the resources they needed to further their education, find fulfilling employment, build resilience, and thrive.



Children's Aid Foundation of Canada is our country's leading charity dedicated to improving the lives of children and youth growing up in the child welfare system. We raise and grant funds, and deliver a wide range of high-impact programs and services in partnership with 104 child- and youth-serving agency partners that support more than 15,000 at-risk children, youth and families.
